For the Chinese, going home is an eternal topic. Especially against the backdrop of the global pandemic, hardened borders, quarantine policies and expensive international airfares in recent years, it has become particularly difficult for overseas Chinese to return to their homeland.

The Home Sweet App is a platform that imitates the features and functions of social media such as WeChat, allowing participants to express their longings for home, while the audiences can access by scanning the QR code on their mobiles and listen to the stories through the immersive experience .

The participants are Chinese currently living in the UK, USA, Australia, Germany, Japan etc. They come from different places in China, aged between 20 and 60, some are students and about to graduate, several have been working overseas for a few years while others have emigrated for more than 10 years. The materials collected from them have transformed by the artistic practice into ink paintings, audio, texts and names that compose a digital space where the real and the fictional are intertwined.

I was inspired by my studies during the MA Contemporary Arts China at Birmingham City University and experimented with ink art that combined different forms of expression such as installation, video, performance and social engage.

Since I arrived in the UK, pandemic and loneliness have driven me to pay extra attention to the mundane and ordinary. After a series of works about the homeless and the found object in Birmingham city, I began to think about the meaning of home.

'I'll be home with my family in a few days and it's all worth it.'




