It also highlights the color characteristics of Birmingham city, mostly brick colors, dark red or cold metallic colors. This colorful space injects a new landscape into the Birmingham city behind it through this terrace. The creation of colorful lines and dry branches with the help of wind. This is a bright space that contrasts sharply with the monotonous colors of Birmingham. It begins in the sun, cooperates with the wind and is washed by the snow, and is also bathed in the night. This is the shape of the wind that blends the noise of the city and the look of the tree. This seems to be the "home" where I and the wind create wind on the branches. The interlacing of wool and branches makes the space also have this innumerable space.
